NO CANOPIES LARGER THEN 10X12 ALLOWED – STRICTLY ENFORCED

1. **Each team to donate a 10 lb bag of uncooked leg quarters to the council.**
2. Entry Fee is \$50. Make checks payable to Knights of Columbus Council #803.
3. Your entry fee will provide you with an assigned space of 10 x 12 (See Map).
Due to lack of space 10x12 area will be strictly enforced.
ONLY BBQ pits fitting in your 10x12 booth allowed.
4. First, Second and Third place trophies will be awarded for best chili. Best decorated booth trophy and beer trophy.
5. Must have meat checked prior to cooking by Judging staff or Cook-Off staff.
No pre-marinated meat.
6. Chili must be made from scratch nothing pre-cooked. Meat may be pre-cut. (5 to 10 gallons of cooked chili meat only, no additives such as beans, rice, corn, etc.)
7. Day of Cook-Off, a meeting will be held with the Head Cooks at 12:00 P.M. inside the Anchor Room.
8. Each team is responsible for the building and removal of their own booths.
9. You must provide your own equipment such as pots, pans, spoons, tables and chairs.
Absolutely no loaning or rental of such equipment will be available.
10. Must wear hair net, cap or hat.
11. Must have cover over the cooking area.
12. Absolutely no electrical outlets are available.
13. Must have fresh water on hand for cleaning and cleaning agent for sanitizing.
14. Turn in time is 3:00 P.M. (Winners announced at 5:00 P.M.)
